Applicants should be aware that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This is a farming environment and days off may be extremely limited during our picking season. Work hours are not calendar based, but are dependent on crop maturity and weather. Work hours are generally at least 60 hours per week, and can be longer. As agricultural employment that overtime provisions do not apply for these positions. <p>Applicants must be available from early July until early to mid Sept 2012.</p>
