Job purpose

Under the direction of the Crew Manager the Tractor Operator Assistant will move cherries from the field to the tractor and load the cherry totes onto the trailer.

Duties and responsibilities

- Loading cherry totes onto the bin trailers safely and efficiently without damaging the fruit or oneself
- Ensuring all faults and maintenance issues are reported to your picking supervisor
- Take part in Health and Safety awareness training

Qualifications

- Fluent in English
- Must be in good health and able to carry out physically demanding tasks as required
- Lifting of 20+ pounds repetitively is required
- Must be a flexible team player who works well in a busy and demanding environment
- Good eye for detail and quality maintenance
- Able to work for extended periods of time in a focused, safe and professional manner

Working conditions

Our working environment is extremely demanding over a short time period. Applicants should be aware that:

- This is a farming environment and days off may be limited during our picking season
- Work is conducted outside, it is advisable to be prepared for weather by wearing layered clothing
- Keep hydrated
- Work hours are not calendar based, but are dependent on crop maturity and weather
- Work hours are generally 60+ hours per week
- Successful candidates begin work at 5:00am
- Overtime provisions do not apply for this position
