<b>Working Conditions</b>			
<p>Our working environment is extremely demanding over a short time period. Applicants should be aware that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This is a farming environment and days off may be extremely limited during our picking season</li> <li>• Work hours are not calendar based, but are dependent on crop maturity and weather</li> <li>• Expect 50 - 80 hours per week, rotated shifts available to ensure sufficient rest</li> <li>• Expect shifts to run between 8am and 11pm depending on picking locations (10-14 hour shifts common)</li> <li>• As agricultural employment that overtime provisions do not apply for these positions</li> </ul> <p>Applicants must be available from <b>June</b> until <b>September</b></p>
